Your health savings account (HSA) is open and here to help you pay for qualified medical expenses. These simple steps will help you use your HSA with confidence.



1. Contribute to your HSA

Add money to your HSA at **anthem.com**. In 2023, you can contribute up to \$3,850 for an individual and \$7,750 for a family. If you start saving now, the money will be there anytime you need it.



2. Activate your debit card

Your card will come in the mail if it hasn't already. Along with it, you will find helpful information about how to access and manage your account.



3. Use your card for qualified medical expenses

Pay for doctor visits, prescriptions, and other qualified medical expenses with your HSA debit card. View a full list of qualified medical expenses at **anthem.com/qme**.



4. Manage your HSA online

View your balance and claims, add money, and go paperless at **anthem.com**. Log in and select **Spending Accounts** under the *My Plan* tab. Then, choose **Manage My Account**.

Don't forget this important step

WealthCare Saver is the custodian for your HSA, which means they manage the money in it. It's important to take the time to read the terms and conditions for using your HSA at **www.wealthcaresaver.com/disclosures/anthem**. When you register for and use your HSA account, you're agreeing to these terms and conditions. It's a good idea to print the documents for your records.

You can change your communication preferences in your account to electronic anytime. If you don't change your preferences, you'll receive important HSA information by mail, including:

- Quarterly HSA statements (a paper statement fee will apply according to your HSA Fee Schedule, which you can find in the Resources section of your **anthem.com** account.)
- Annual tax statements
- Account notices for overdrafts, address changes, customer identification program (CIP) communications, and account closures
- Annual WealthCare Saver Privacy Policy
